### Directions

#### From Albany on I-88

Take exit 2 (Chenango Bridge). At the end of the exit, go straight at the traffic light. At the stop sign, turn left onto Chenango Road. Go about 1 mile, turn left on Nowlan Road. (There is a gas station.)

\*Proceed ½ mile, then turn right onto Franklin Avenue Extension. (It is a dirt road, just over the railroad tracks.) Follow this road to the end to the campground.

#### From I-81

Take exit 4N. (Hillcrest Route 7) Follow Route 7 north, and keep going straight at the traffic light.

\*Exit at Hillcrest/Service Road exit. (Stay at the right side.) At the four-way stop sign, go straight. Take a right at the next traffic light onto Nowlan Road.

\* Follow directions as before.

### Lodging & Meals

Bring your own bedding.

Children under 5 years of age eat free and must be accompanied by an adult.

Children ages 5-11 eat at half price.

Sunday meals are on a free-will offering basis.

#### Youth

There is a work program for youth age 12 and over to earn a meal ticket. Young people must be recommended by their pastor.

### Parent – Guardian

In accordance with state regulations, no unattended young people (ages 11-17) will be permitted to stay overnight unless they have completed a “Health Registration” signed by their parent or guardian.

These forms are available from any of the zone pastors or at the camp registration desk.

The State Health Board has placed regulations upon summer camps or any place where young people under 18 years of age are unaccompanied by parents or guardians. The Broome County Board of Health is enforcing these regulations.
