Marzo 9

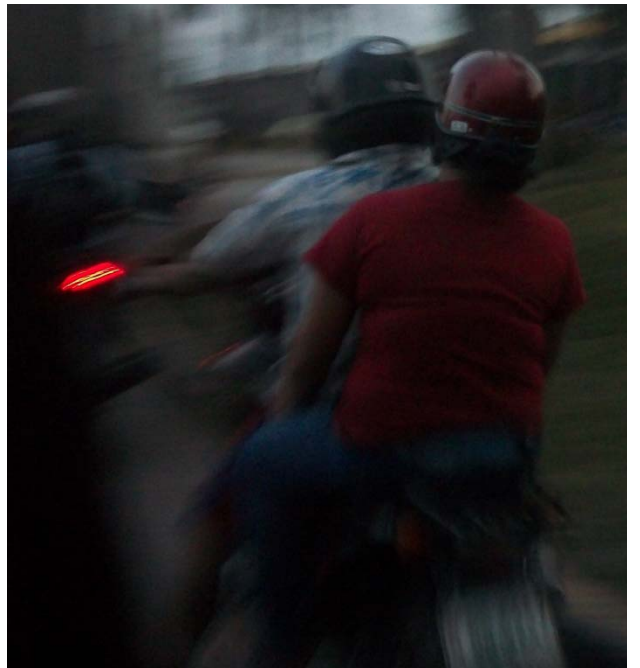
